His extensive research has been published in the areas of evidence-based medicine, managed medical and disability systems, access to care, return-to-work and performance indicators in California's workers' compensation reform.

He earned his Master's degree in Strategic Planning and Health Services Research from George Washington University, where he was awarded the International Research Fellowship Award.
